Recreation Update – Rachel Kaminski, YMCA

- Rachel promoted the youth program at Meadow View Primary today
- Rachel's now certified to teach Silver Sneakers Yoga
- Yoga reached its capacity, looking at more equipment
- May Senior Center newsletter is out
- New card group coming, the week is filled
- Newsletter generated \$800 for the Senior Center budget
- Senior Center is in need of a van driver, 3 days/week, 3-4 hours, paid position
- 7 signed up for Marsh Haven, YMCA bus being used

Pool Update – Jacob Van Den Berg, YMCA

- May 20: in-service training day employees, police, etc
- May 30: water has to be ready to go for training
- Swim lessons need to be booked for Candace Wojahn Start Out Safe program (SOS)
- YMCA will do more advertising for SOS, lessons are June 12-15
- Supplies are being ordered throughout the next month
- DPW will put up shade soon

Water Barrel Contest

- Funding will be handled through the Fire Department
- Location is to be determined

Pickelball – Barb Armga

- Pickleball numbers are up
- Currently 3 courts at The Union
- 2 courts outside, more are needed
- Rock River will allow them to paint lines
- Waupun Lions will pay for paint and labor
- New courts at WAHS will have pickleball

- \$2,000 request
- Lighting is needed around batting cage
- Storage unit on diamond 3
- \$2,000 grant in 2016

Gridiron Association (Youth Football) – Jeff Tavs

- \$2,000 request
- Equipment
- Cost of emergency personnel at games, officials and scholarship monies \$500
- \$2,500 grant in 2016

Hoopsters (Youth Basketball) – Kevin Homan

- Funding request amount not listed
- Help to make payments on shooting machine that cost \$6,500
- To add more teams as the amount of kids are increasing
- \$2,500 grant in 2016

Hunter Education – no representation

- \$700 request
- \$500 grant in 2016

Youth Wrestling – no representation

- \$1,000 request

Youth Soccer – Ryan Farley and Mike Gillenkerk

- Requesting maximum grant
- 600 forecasted for 2017
- Need new nets and balls
- \$2,000 grant in 2016

Gun Club - Nathan Mertz

- Requesting \$1,300
- First time submitting a grant request
- 30 kids involved and they need equipment badly

- Roof, throwing equipment is \$7,000, pigeons, etc
- Trying to get a high school team started, boys and girls

Hockey Association – Natalie Mauer

- Water bottle filling station
- Need new rental skates for Friday and Sunday nights (open skating)
- Crowd control dividers for roping off areas
- Number of kids is not growing, maybe 70 families
- Compressor needs to be replaced, \$26,000
- Possibility of a minor team coming if locker rooms are built, cost is \$500,000
- \$2,000 grant in 2016
